Our Story

HOW WE MET

Bob: We met just a few days after I returned from the Philippines in August 1946, and was discharged from the Army. I went with Dan Leddy to see the girl he was dating, Frances Lamont, who was working late into the evening to help clean the office at Bud Antle's lettuce packing company. Janet also worked in that office but she had an infected finger and couldn't help with the cleaning work. She sat around all evening holding her sore finger in the air while the rest of us cleaned. The four of us went to Landis' Restaurant in Freedom afterwards for a coke. **Janet:** I was the receptionist at Bud Antle Co. in Watsonville. Dan Leddy brought Bob into the office to see Frances Lamont who was working during the summer of 1946. The three were mutual friends. Dan introduced me to Bob. Dan and Bob then helped Frances clean venetian blinds because I had an infection in my finger. It had just been lanced so I couldn't get it wet. I still hear about not helping clean those blinds.

OUR COURTSHIP

Bob: We had an occasional date after we met, but then I lost contact with her. I thought Janet had returned to South Dakota, but later found out that it was only for Christmas. I believe it was when she replied to my Christmas card that I discovered she was still in California. In early 1947, I became more serious about her. Her spiritual dedication impressed me and I began dating her more frequently. **Janet:** We dated several times during the summer-going to movies, dances, the beach, etc. I then went to South Dakota to be with my parents at Christmas. In January or February 1947, I sent Bob a card just to say hello and we started seeing each other again. When he called me, he said that he thought I had moved back to South Dakota. We often went flying, as Bob had his pilot's license at the time. I especially liked flying out of Capitola at night. The view was beautiful. Also, we went to dances in Santa Cruz and one barn dance in the area. Picnics were fun, too. We went on one picnic with Dan and Evelyn. I believe it was at Arroyo Seco.

OUR ENGAGEMENT

Bob: In May 1947, Janet traveled to San Luis Obispo to be my guest at the Poly Royal Ball-I was going to school at Cal Poly under the GI Bill at the time. Before the dance, we went to dinner at the F & M Inn. Although we had previously discussed marriage, it was there that I gave Janet her engagement ring.

Janet: We were engaged in April. Bob proposed at the beach. It was a beautiful night with the moonlight reflected in the ocean. He gave me my engagement ring in San Luis Obispo. We went to dinner that night with Dan and Evelyn at a nice restaurant. Dan kept playing the same song (Heartaches) on the juke box. Bob and Dan kept giggling about it all evening.

Remembering Our Wedding Day

August 17, 1947

DATE

St. Patrick's Church, Watsonville, California

PLACE

Special Memories

Bob: Our wedding was at 2:00 PM and Steve Duer was my Best Man. I remember him showing me the proper way to pin on a boutonniere and to tie a modified Windsor knot in my necktie, while suggesting that this was my last chance to escape to South America. I didn't want to do that, but I would have preferred that Janet and I elope. I was scared stiff as I waited at the altar while Janet came down the aisle. Bill gave her away as her Dad was harvesting in South Dakota. After the ceremony, we couldn't get back down the aisle and out of the church quick enough. The pastor didn't allow pictures taken in the church, so we didn't have that ordeal to go through. Steve drove Bill's Pontiac to the reception at the home, where we did have pictures taken. I don't remember too much of what went on at the reception except combing my hair in the bathroom and having rice fly all over. Janet and I finally escaped out the attached-garage door and eluded pursuers through back alleys in Chuck's (Charlie Herbert's) 1936 Ford. We went to the Green Valley Ranch where my 1933 Ford Coupe was parked-the car we used for our honeymoon. After detaching the shoes and cans that had been tied to the back bumper, we were off.

Janet: I remember being very nervous because I was shy to be in front of so many people. Bob had suggested sometime earlier that we elope and I was wishing I would have taken him up on it. Actually, even though I was nervous, I was very happy to become Bob's wife. I knew he was a wonderful person and we were very much in love. It was a beautiful wedding and reception, and one I will always remember.

Honeymoon Memories

Bob: When we left the Green Valley Ranch in our '33 Ford Coupe, we circled around Wheelock Road and across Casserly Road to evade pursuit. Then we headed over Hecker Pass for Berkeley (Highway 17 wasn't built yet). Our first night was to be in a hotel there. On the way to Berkeley, people would pass us and wave or honk. We couldn't figure out why, because we had removed all the cans and signs. But we pulled over just to check again. We soon found the answer -- a single leather moccasin dragging silently behind us. I knew immediately who had tied it on and stored it underneath on the frame until the bumps would jar it loose -- Dad (later called Pappy).

The next morning we departed for Sacramento which was to be our second-night stay -- at Hotel Berry. Somewhere along the way we stopped for lunch. The woman who owned the restaurant immediately recognized us as newlyweds and served a small bottle of champaign "on the house." We drank just a little because I had to drive, but we appreciated the gesture anyway. Hotel Berry was in downtown Sacramento -- close to the capitol building and other places of interest. At the cathedral we bought a Saint Christopher medal with wings to pin on the headlining above the windshield. We've carried it in every car since then. It is now buried in the glove box somewhere.

Our final destination was a motel at Lake Tahoe where we stayed a week. We went swimming (Brrrrr), boating, and speedboat riding. We made a trip to Reno where we came out a little ahead playing the slot machines. It was there that I bought my naked lady paperweight and bottle opener which Janet never has fully appreciated. Our motel had a kitchenette where we did some of our cooking and ate out part of the time. When we went to the grocery store for supplies, everyone asked us if we were newlyweds. We couldn't figure out how they could tell. Well, those are the highlights, so guess it is enough.

Janet: It was so good to at last be alone and on our way to Tahoe. We had reservations at a nice hotel in Oakland. When we arrived to check in, we were very surprised that the room we had reserved for our wedding night had twin beds. Of course the manager was very apologetic, but it was the only room they had available. But then, who cared anyhow?

The next morning we went on to Tahoe and found it very beautiful and the weather was really nice, but hot. It was my first trip there. It was also the first time I had been out in a boat on the lake. I was a little nervous because I didn't know how to swim at the time. As I recall, the engine was hard to start every time Bob tried it.

The long, hot drive over Tioga Pass on the way home was almost too much for Inky, our old Ford Coupe, but we made it.


Dear Mom & Dad,

Dear Mom and Dad,




And about that thing, that scourge, of the child becoming a parent and becoming his parents, saying and doing what they said and did to him —




Love, the Greatest Thing

If I had the gift of being able to speak in other languages without learning them, and could speak in every language there is in all of heaven and earth, but didn't love others, I would only be making noise.

If I had the gift of prophecy and knew all about what is going to happen in the future, knew everything about everything, but didn't love others, what good would it do? Even if I had the gift of faith so that I could speak to a mountain and make it move, I would still be worth nothing at all without love.

If I gave everything I have to poor people, and if I were burned alive for preaching the Gospel but didn't love others, it would be of no value whatever.

Love is very patient and kind, never jealous or envious, never boastful or proud, never haughty or selfish or rude. Love does not demand its own way. It is not irritable or touchy. It does not hold grudges and will hardly even notice when others do it wrong.

It is never glad about injustice, but rejoices whenever truth wins out.

If you love someone you will be loyal to him no matter what the cost. You will always believe in him, always expect the best of him, and always stand your ground in defending him.

All the special gifts and powers from God will someday come to an end, but love goes on forever. Someday prophecy, and speaking in unknown languages, and special knowledge - These gifts will disappear. Now we know so little, even with our special gifts, and the preaching of those most gifted is still so poor. But when we have been made perfect and complete, then the need for these inadequate special gifts will come to an end, and they will disappear.

It's like this: When I was a child I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child does. But when I became a man my thoughts grew far beyond those of my childhood, and now I have put away the childish things. In the same way, we can see and understand only a little about God now, as if we were peering at his reflection in a poor mirror; but someday we are going to see him in his completeness, face to face. Now all that I know is hazy and blurred, but then I will see everything clearly, just as clearly as God sees into my heart right now.

There are three things that remain

Faith, Hope, and Love
and the greatest of these is
LOVE.
