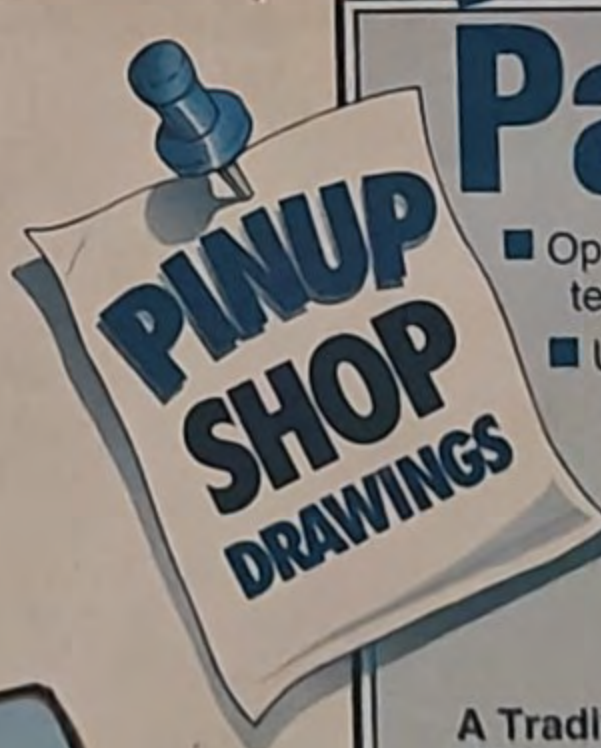

Full-Size Patterns



- Open staples carefully, remove pattern and fold staples back in place.
- Use graphite paper (available at art supply stores) or cut and trace full size patterns onto your stock.
- Cut out the elevation drawings and pin them to your shop wall.

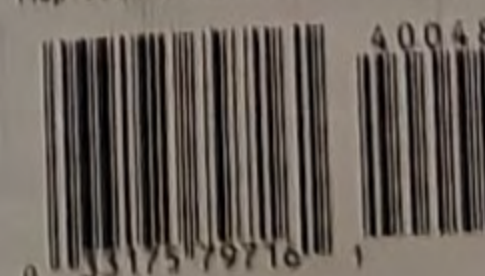
The plan shows three styles for propeller systems, giving you a choice for all of your weathervane projects.

To help you decorate the weathervanes, suggested color schemes are also offered in the plan.



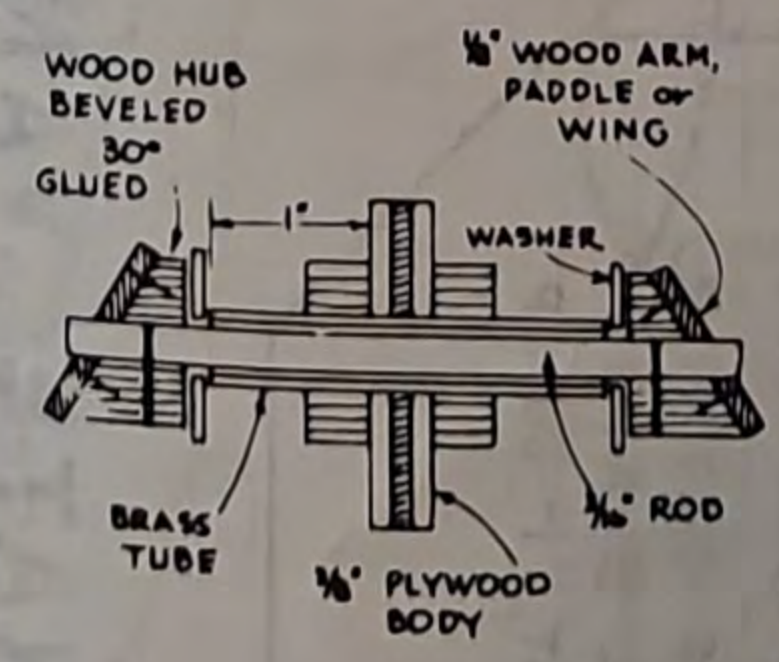
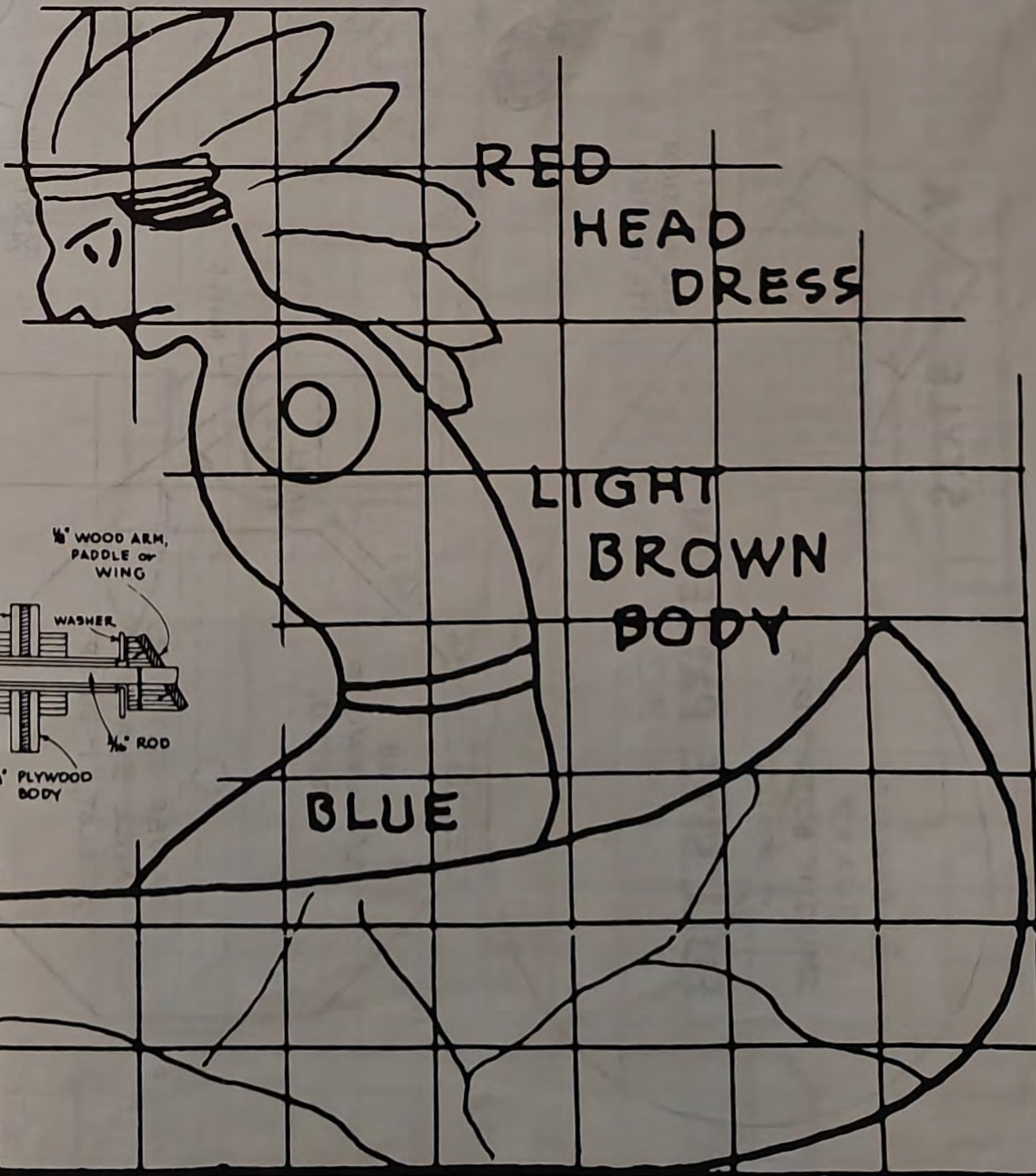
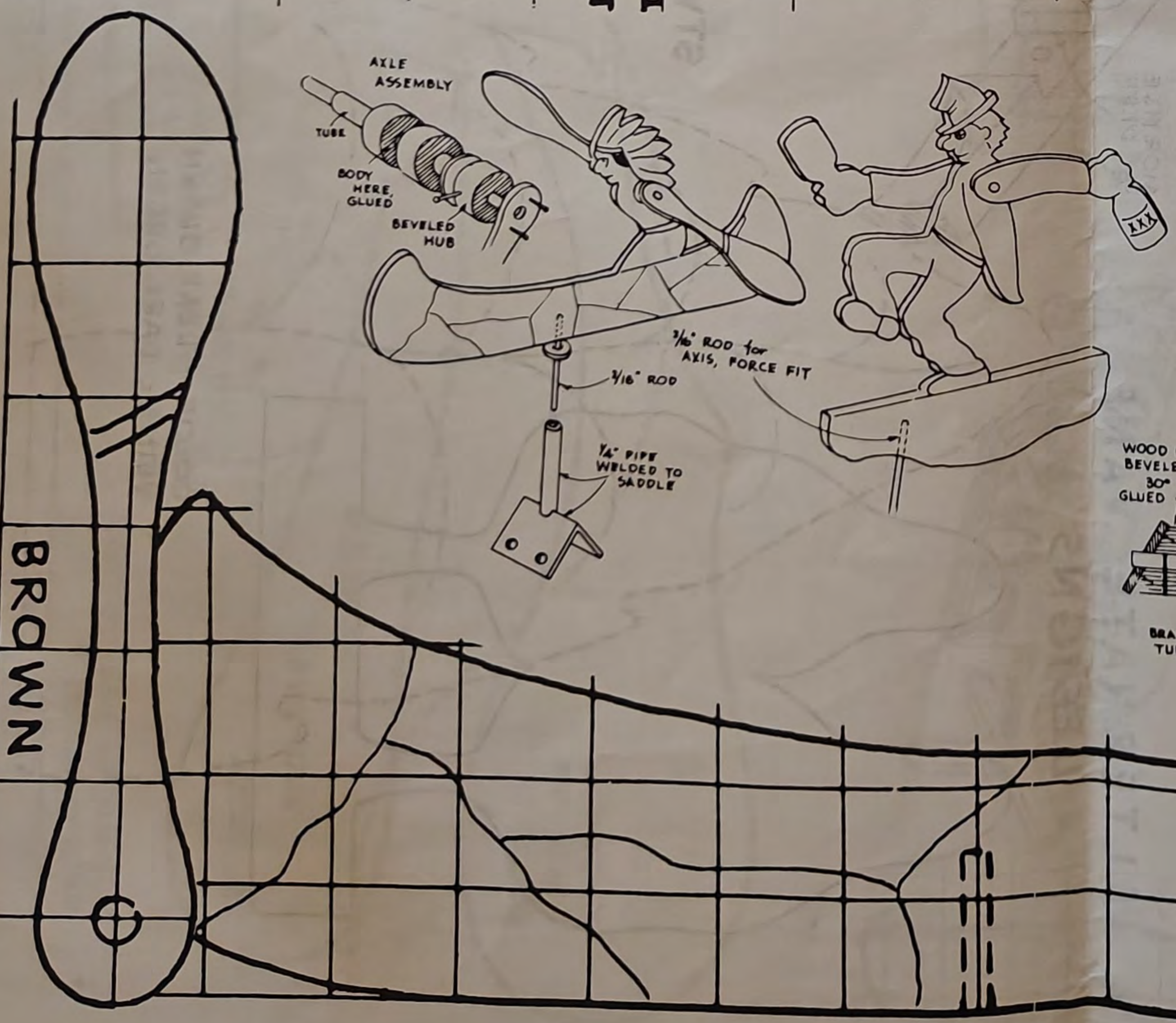
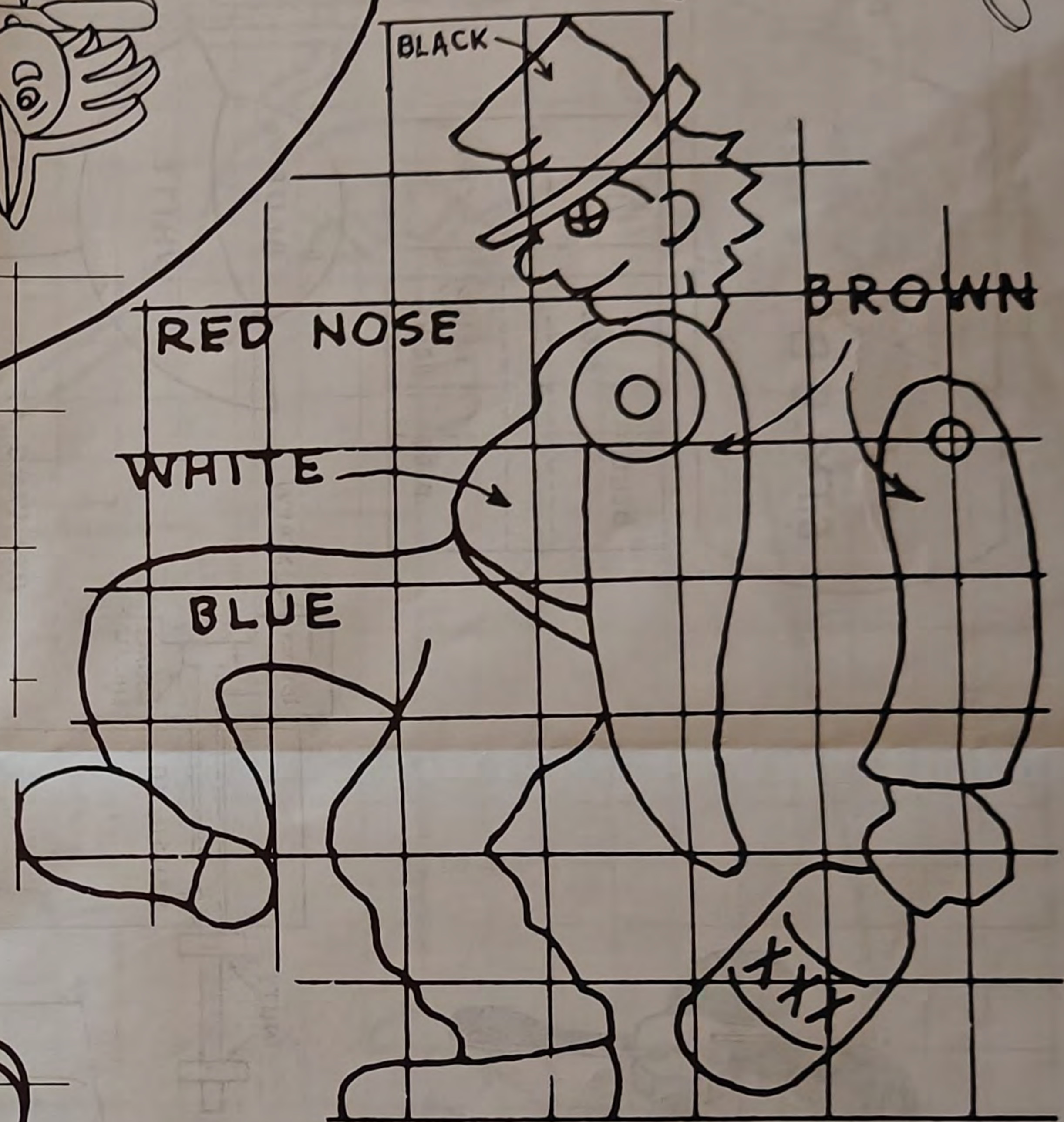
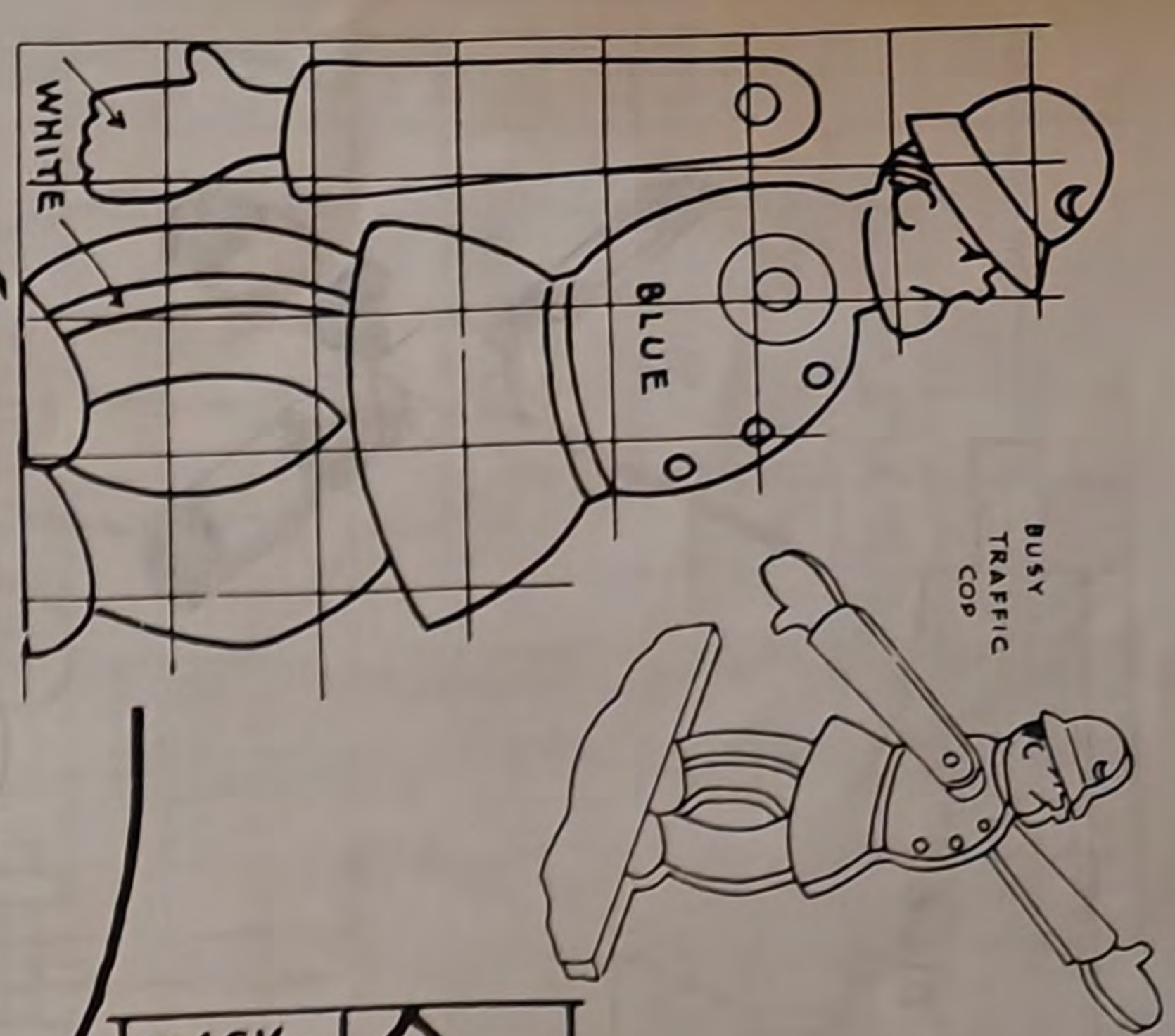
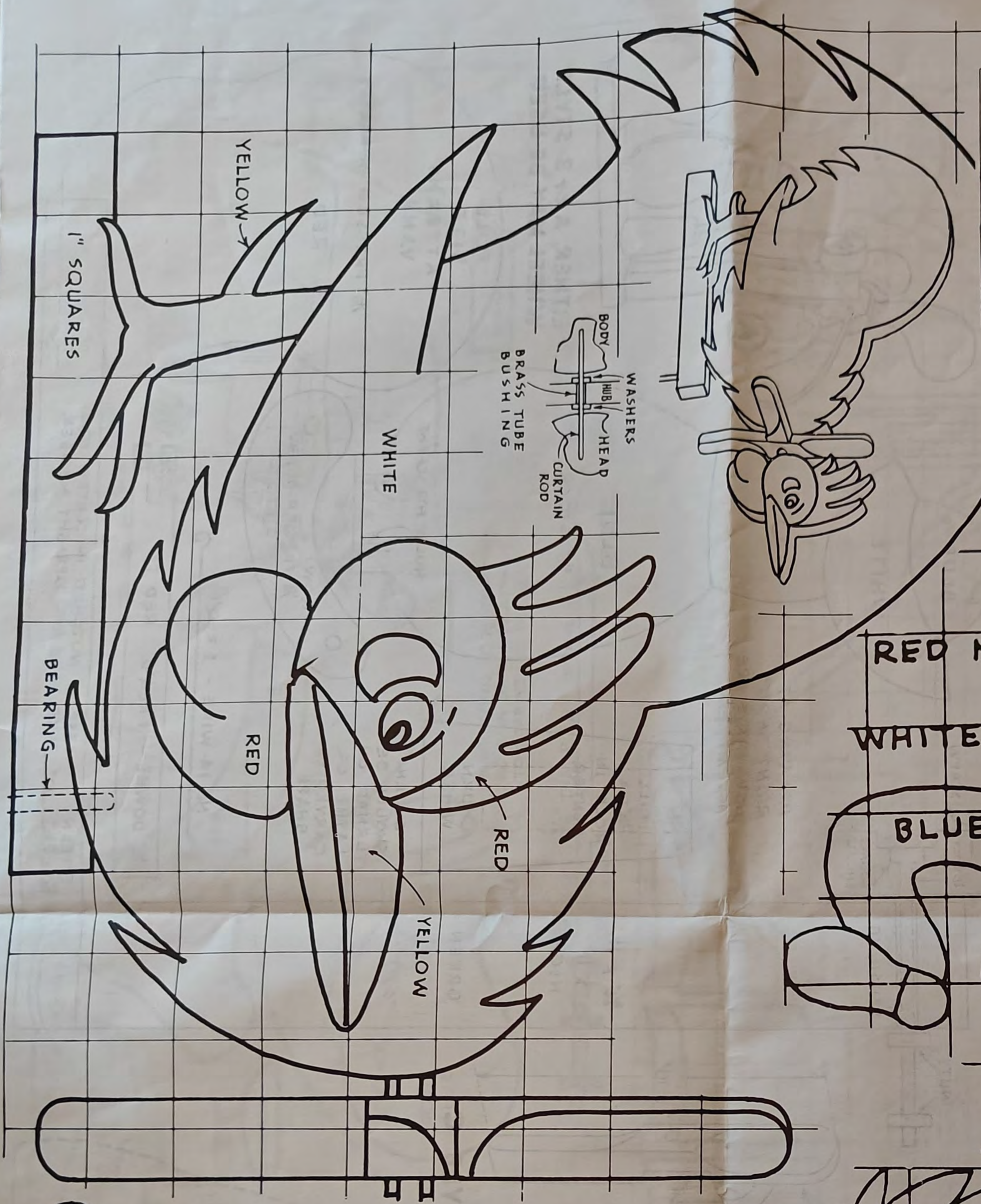

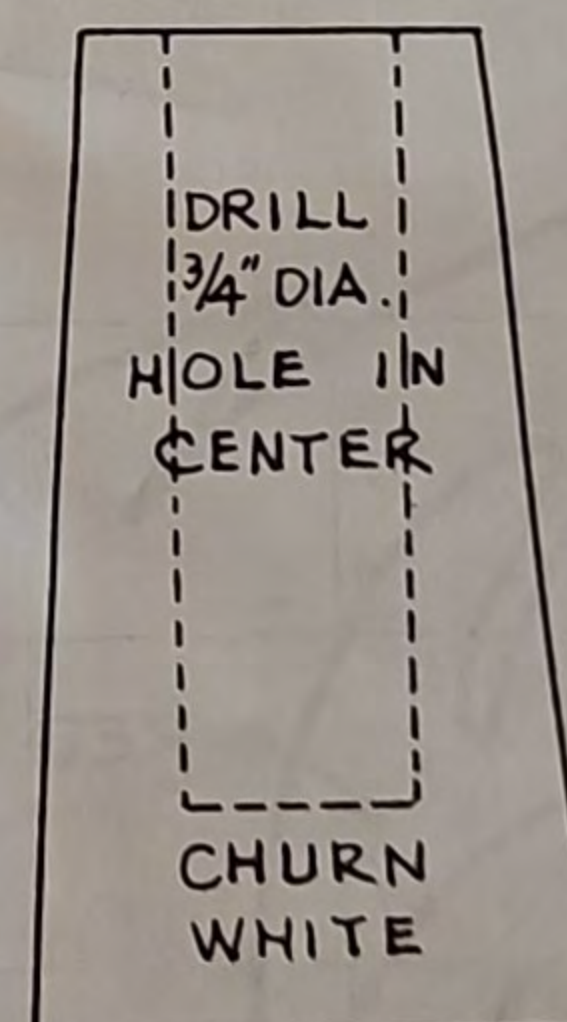




ALTERNATE VANE DESIGNS

ASSEMBLED

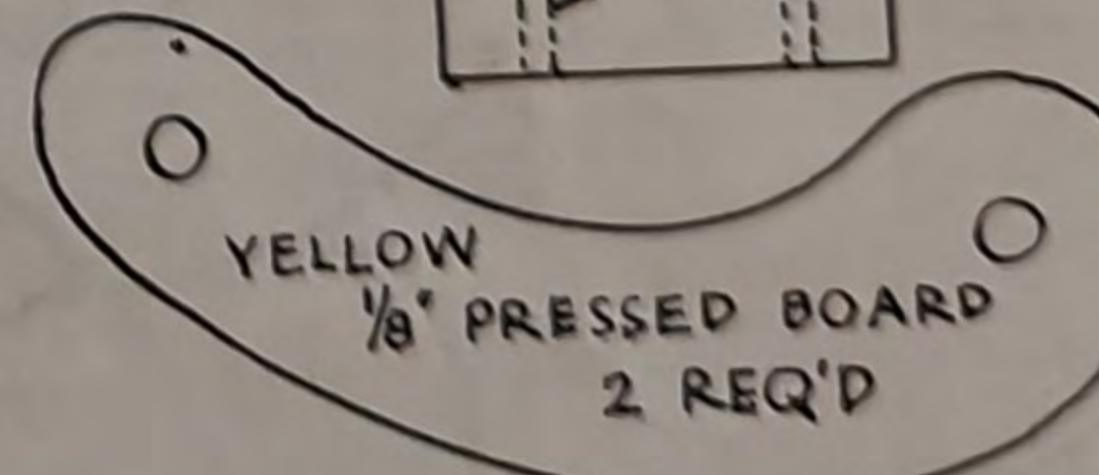
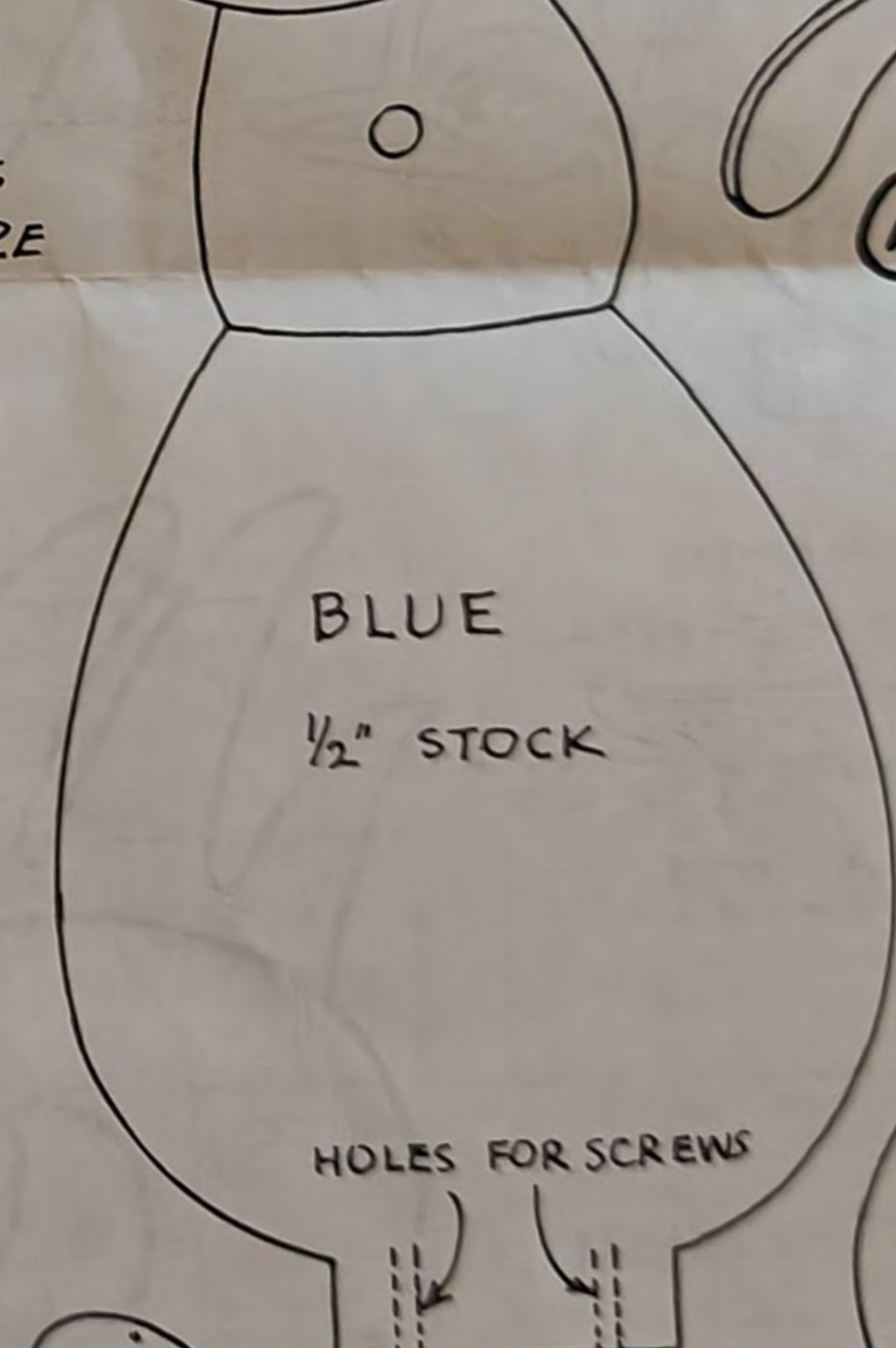
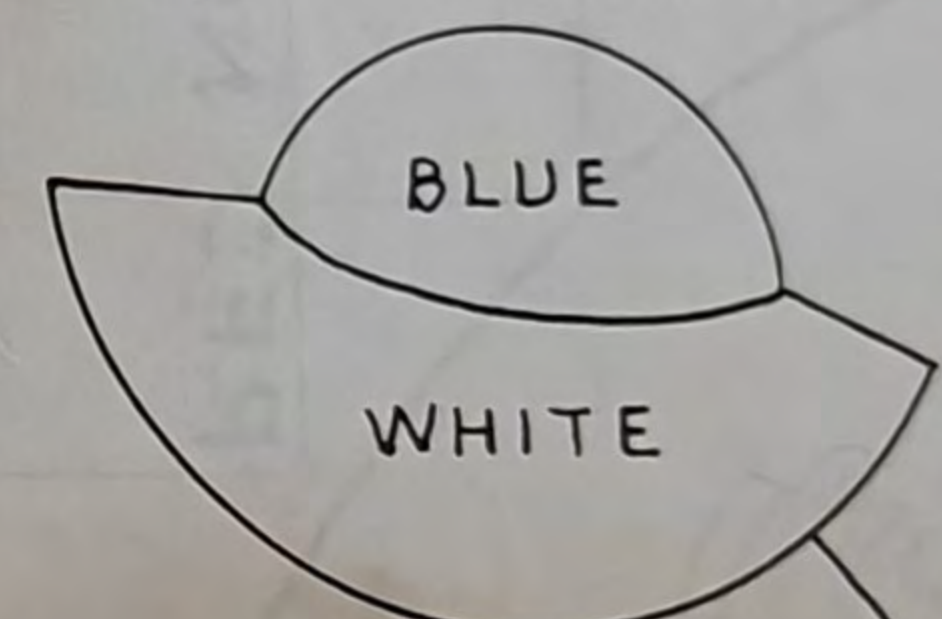
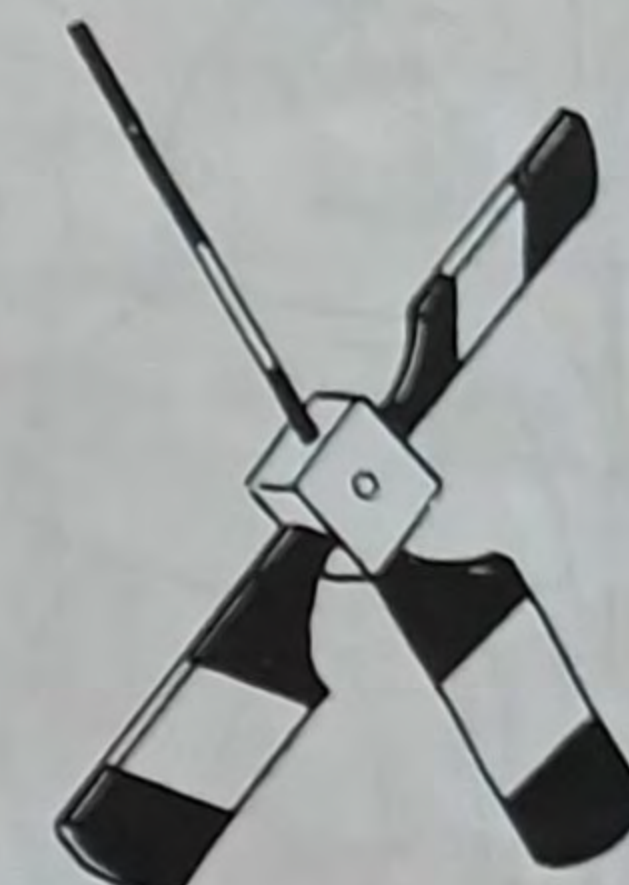
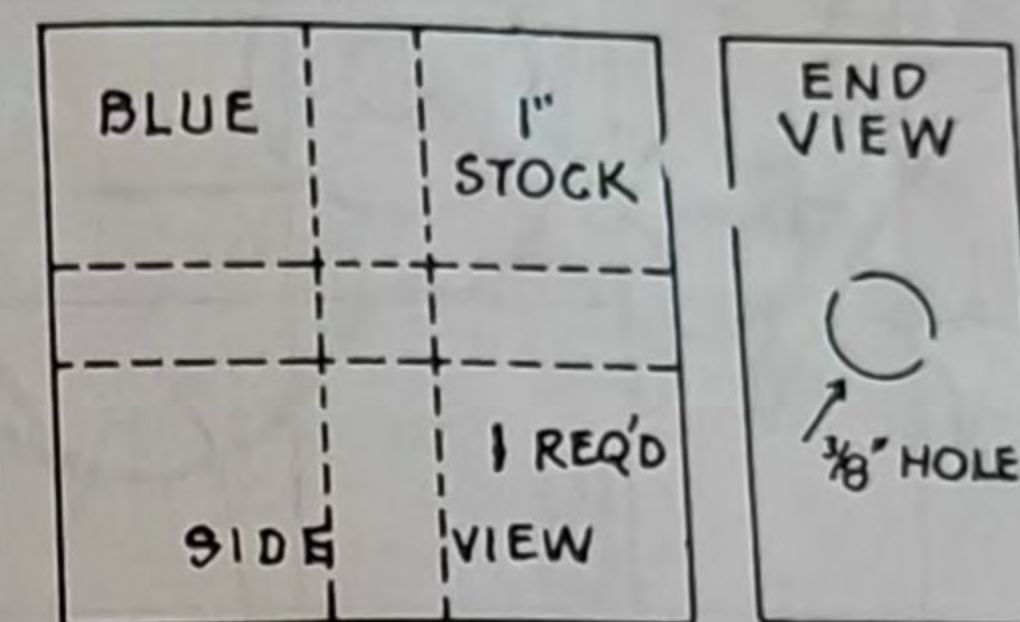
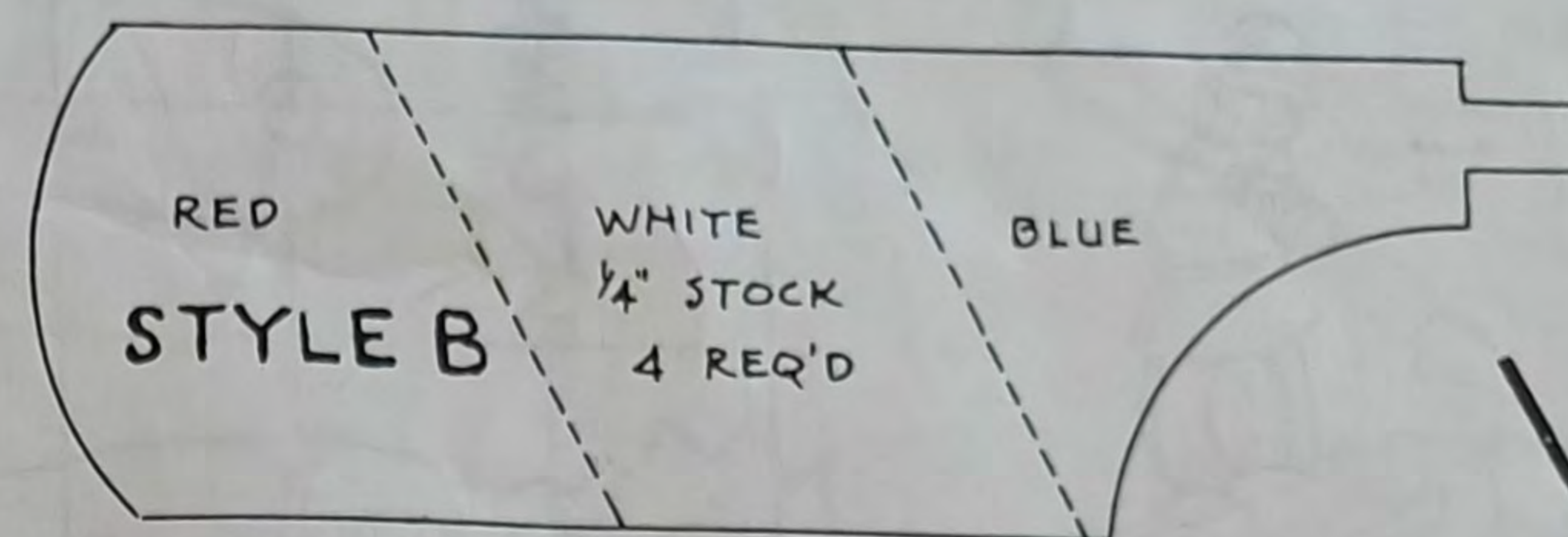
