

Thursday, May 13, 1948

134th day — 232 days follow

We got to the hospital at shortly after 3 P.M. and I went right to bed. The nurses prepped me (shaved, gave an enema, etc.) Bob and mother stayed with me until about 5 P.M. I was too far under to know just what was going on. The nurses would not allow Bob nor mother to stay with me during labor. Creston Lery was born at 11:02 P.M., weighed 6 lbs. 2 1/4 oz. Bob and mother came in to see me in an hour or so. I saw Creston in the afternoon but was still rather dopey and groggy. I didn't sleep too well tonight. Bob & mother came in to see me tonight & I hated to see them go. Of course, Creston is the most wonderful baby in the world & I will never forget our first meeting.

Friday, May 14, 1948

135th day — 231 days follow

I washed myself, brushed my teeth, etc. this morning. Bob couldn't come to see me at 2 P.M. so Mother took a bus out & stayed until 4. I slept for a while after dinner. Received a card, baby book, 2 pairs booties, and some powder from Bob's folks. I got terribly lonesome for Bob this afternoon. He and Mom came in from 7 to 8 and the time went so fast. I saw Cres tonight for the second time — He's so sweet. I slept good tonight and fed Cres for the first time at 2 A.M.
